

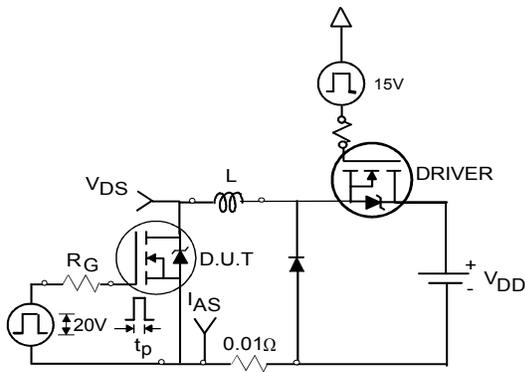
**Fig 15. Maximum Avalanche Energy vs. Temperature**

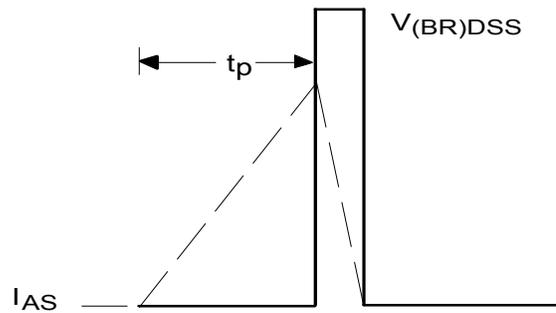

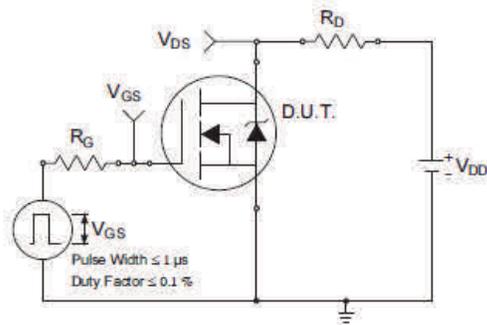
**Fig 21.** Peak Diode Recovery  $dv/dt$  Test Circuit for N-Channel HEXFET® Power MOSFETs



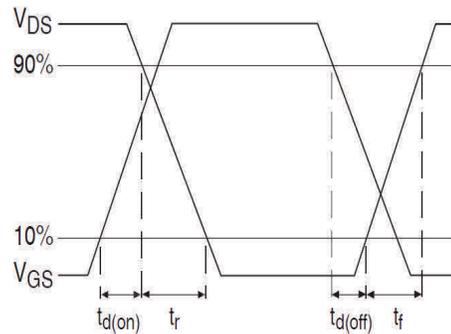
**Fig 22a.** Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit




**Fig 22b.** Unclamped Inductive Waveforms




**Fig 23a.** Switching Time Test Circuit




**Fig 23b.** Switching Time Waveforms
